## 2020 Corvette: Here Are The Five Wheel Choices

Chevy's all-new 2020 Corvette will initially offer five wheel options, comprised of one standard wheel and four available wheels. GM Authority has compiled a comprehensive guide to 2020 Corvette wheels, complete with pictures, availability info, and other details for your browsing and shopping pleasure.

All five 2020 Corvette wheel options are made of aluminum, feature a staggered 19-inch front and 20-inch rear setup and are 8.5 inches wide, while varying in design and finish.







In addition, wheel availability is the same across 1LT, 2LT, and 3LT models, meaning each trim level receives the same standard wheel – the bright silver-painted Q8P. One of the five sets (5DF) is a Genuine Corvette Accessory, thus they are included as a second set of wheels when purchased. All 2020 Corvette wheels available from the factory are shown below.











The table below lists the 5 sets of 2020 Corvette wheels, along

with the corresponding RPO Codes, diameters, widths, finishes, and trim level availability.
